Daily Scripture Reading

- Colossians 4:2-6 -

Paul saw himself as an apostle, through and through. He was sent by the risen Jesus to make the gospel known, to plant churches where they didn't yet exist and to establish leaders to oversee the life of these gospel outposts. As people joined the Jesus Movement, Paul and his co-workers taught them to not only receive the gospel but to join in its ministry. They were partners in the mission of God to see the world reconciled in Christ. You can hear this heartbeat in Paul's instructions here: 1) followers of Jesus are to be a people awake in grateful prayer; 2) Churches should pray specifically for messengers of the gospel, that the message would be unimpeded; and 3) Followers of Jesus must be mindful of their own behaviour and speech and the effect these may have on what those outside the church perceive of Jesus.

Today I echo Paul's request on behalf of those serving within the Mainly Music and Ark Mums and Bubs group teams: Pray for them, that God may open a door to them for the gospel, that they may make it known. Let's get behind these teams in prayer!
