**Reflection:** In the minds of their society, the Jesus-followers Peter addressed were disloyal to Rome, met secretly, practised strange rituals and generally kept a counter-cultural lifestyle. Consequently, they were persistently attacked, slandered and mocked for their faith. Peter had responded to Roman political power with the sword (John 18:10), but now he responded to Roman social power with a word of encouragement: stand firm. Remember Christ's authority and prize him at the core of your being; don't fall away from him in your testing. And further, expect to be asked about the hope we share! Each of you is a witness and should be prepared to humbly speak as such in honour of the one you point others to.

While it's unlikely you are being persecuted like Peter's original audience, we still need to hear his message. Are we holding fast to Christ to endure our tests? Do we know the same living hope, and are we prepared to illuminate enquirers? Let's pray today for our gospel witness to the families we meet in our community.
